Roads and drains in Antingham

I just wanted to give you a quick update on a couple of issues I have been working on together with residents of Antingham.

Last year the Parish Council raised concerns about safety at **the junction of Southrepps Road and the A149**. I met with the local highways engineer and members of the Parish Council to look at the junction and County Highways then did some hedge cutting to improve visibility at the junction.

We also talked about improved signage on the approach to the junction but this didn't happen during 'Lockdown'. Now, after some chasing by the Parish Clerk, Highways have been back to take a look and have agreed to paint SLOW signs on the road and to re-paint the existing lines.

Highways have also agreed to take a look at a number of problems relating to drains on **Elderton Lane**. These contribute to persistent flooding on the road. A couple of the issues should be quick fixes but at least one needs a bit more work. I will keep chasing them to sort the problems out.

You might have seen me in the local newspaper expressing my frustration at how long it has taken to fix the bridge at Swafield. It's really part of a bigger problem – County Hall doesn't want to take a proper look at the roads in this area and spend some money on long term solutions to improve safety. It's something I am going to keep calling for over the coming months. Hopefully most of the traffic by-passes Antingham but it's a campaign that I hope everyone in the area can get behind.
