

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C634 Cromer Road from a point 770 metres east of its junction with the C291 Southrepps Road for a distance of 40 metres east in the PARISH OF TRIMINGHAM because of repairs to electricity pole on roadside.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 09:00 hours to 15:00 hours on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be 6 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: Cromer Road, Church Street, Mundesley Road, High Street, Trunch Road, Southrepps Road, Gimingham Road, Chapel Street, Thorpe Road, Southrepps Footpath 8, North Walsham Road, Crossdale Street, Norwich Road, Cromwell Road, Overstrand Road, Main Road (Overstrand/ Cromer/ Gimingham/ Southrepps/ Northrepps/ Trunch/ Mundesley/ Sidestrand).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
